I give and bequeath all my said Residue to Mary Ann Calder daughter of Alex-
ander and Mary Calder, Phebe Hynson, Mary Hynson, Welthy Ann Hynson
Sarah Hynson and Rebecca Hynson all daughters of John Carwill Hynson equally
to be divided between them and to the Survivors of them equally to be divided
between them. ~~Item~~ Lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my Sister Hannah
Hynson to be Executrix of this my last Will and Testament annulling all former Wills
by me heretofore made and confirming this and none other to be my last Will and
Testament, In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affixed my
Seal this twentieth day of August in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven
hundred and Eighty eight.
