 pounds ten shillings, my Clock & fourteen pounds, four  
 table <sup>silver</sup> spoons at three pounds, my great Chest standing in my  
 Hall at one pound ten shillings, my Close Press at two pounds  
 ten shillings. — 2<sup>d</sup> My Will is that my son John Carvil Hyuson  
 have my trunk and case marked with the Letters F+M with a large  
 Cassiter and tin Sugar ~~box~~ trunk in it Estimated at four pounds  
 his second choice of Beds & furniture at six pounds, his first choice  
 of my Desks two pounds, six table silver spoons at four pounds ten  
 shillings, six Chancery Coffe cups & three D. & Shop Bowl Twenty shillings.  
 3<sup>d</sup> My Will is that my son Richard Hyuson have my Chappace tea-  
 table by Estimation twelve shillings, and third choice Bed & furniture  
 at 5 L, . . . 4<sup>th</sup> I give unto my grand Daughter Waltham Rolph  
 Daughter of John Rolph & Shebey his wife one Negro Lad named  
 Baccus, — 5<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Daughter Shebey Rolph wife of John  
 Rolph all the Remainder of my Chancery by Estimation fifteen shillings  
 her fourth choice of my Beds & furniture Best Kugg. five pounds &  
 Chest of Drawers & Dressing Glass at three pounds —  
 6<sup>th</sup> I give unto my grand Daughter Martha Rolph one Negro Girl  
 named Jane, 7<sup>th</sup> I give unto my grand Daughter Martha Hanson  
 Daughter of Peuse Hanson & Mary Hanson his wife one Negro Girl  
 Baccus, fifth Bed & furniture four pounds. . . 8<sup>th</sup> I give ~~unto my~~  
 grand Daughter Sarah Hyuson one Negro boy James,
