10th I give unto my Sister Mary Jones one Cow & Calf

12th I give Elizabeth Dunn wife of J^o. Dunn one Seat in my Pew
in S^t. Pauls Parish during her Natural life

13th I give one Negro Man named Jeff unto my son John Carvel Hyuson

14th My Will full Intent and meaning is that my three sons Charles
Hyuson, John Carvel Hyuson, and Richard Hyuson have the several
~~pieces~~ Articles above mentioned in my Will at the several prices set

down opposite the Articles, and that what ever the one have more in
then another is to be repuned & ascertained in my Estate
Value, to be equally divided as hereafter mentioned (as follows)


And first. I give unto my five Grand Children Charles Hyuson son of
Charles Hyuson, Phoebe Hyuson Daughter of John Carvel Hyuson
Sarah Hyuson Daughter of aforesaid John Carvel Hyuson & Rebecca
his wife, Waltham Rolph Daughter of John Rolph & Phoebe his wife
Martha Rolph Daughter of afores. each & every one of them over &
above what I have Deeded & bequeathed unto each of them five
shillings specie and no more of my Estate

secondly. My will is that after my three sons ~~have~~ comply with my
requisition and the overplus of the several Articles be estimated in
my Estate that each & every one of them have five shillings paid to
each of them and no more of my Estate.

3rd I give all the remainder of my personal Estate to be equally
divided amongst all my Grand Children meaning those to whom
I have not set of with five shillings specie.

Lastly I nominate & appoint my son Charles Hyuson sole Executor of
this my last Will and Testament utterly revoking making ^{Null} void
all other other Wills made by me in any wise this 21 day of Sept^r 1702
