Item I do constitute & appoint my well beloved friends Isaac Perkins of Leger Everett and Rafin Gale trustees to my Estate to see the performance of this my last Will Testament and the ordering of all things for the good of my wife & Children.

My Will & request is that my said trustees take care that my Children is well Educated and in good order brought up to Learning, for what use may be thought necessary, and not to be at their own dispose, or in possession of any part of their Estate untill they are of Age, and then to do nothing without the advice & approbation of my said trustees,

For the particuler Confirmation of all singular the premises to all intents and purposes do declare this to be my last Will Testament and no other In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal
