In the Name of God Amen I James McLean of Kent County in the State of Maryland being sick and weak in Body but of sound & disposing mind and memory, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs do therefore make and publish this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following

First and principally I commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my Body to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors herein after named, and after my Debts & funeral charges are paid I devise and bequeath as follows.

Item my Will and desire is that the Marriage Articles or Contract with my dear Wife be complied with by my Executors, and that they in one year after my decease do pay unto my said wife a sum of money equal to one fourth part of my personal Estate as the same

shall be appraised (all Just Demands being first satisfied) and in case my wife should choose such House furniture and plate as belonged to her at the time of our Marriage and what shall be remaining at the time of my decease and undisposed of (the flock excepted) and also a negro man called Will and likewise my Chaise & Chaise Horse in part of the said sum that then my Will is that she shall have all or any of the said Articles at their Valuation or Appraisement in part as aforesaid, and also such
