The declaration or deposition of Thomas Bedingfield Horner
who on the seventh day of March 1783 personally appeared
before me the subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace for Kent
County afo and being sworn on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty
God. deposed and saith, that being sent for by the deceased James
M. Cleare of the County afo on the evening of the 5 of february last
Past, he went to his House the next day, that he found him lying
on the Bed with his clothes on except his coat & waistcoat, that
after some conversation the deceased M. Cleare told this deponent
he had sent for him to draw for him another Will (this
deponent having drawn one for him about two years before)
that this deponent asked the deceased if a Justice to his said former
Will would not do the deceased said No, for as there were great
