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In the name of God amen I John Yearly of Kent County in the State of Maryland being sick and weak of Body, but thanks be to God of sound disposing sense and memory do make & ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner & form following

1. I give and bequeath unto my Son Will Yearly all that part of my of my Land lying on the East side of the main road leading down to Eastern Neck during my wifes Widowhood
2. I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Yearly all the Land & Improvem^{ts} where my son William now lives at the death of his Mother Elizabeth Yearly or day of Marriage to him and his Heirs forever, and my Will and desire is that the residue of my Land furnish my Son Henry with firewood and Rails during his natural life
3. I give and bequeath to my son Edward Yearly forty Acres of Land
