declare the same to be his last Will & Testament, that at the time of
his so doing he was to the best of their Apprehensions of sound & disposing
mind, memory, and Understanding, and that they these deponents
together with Joshua Browning the other Subscribing Witness
respectively subscribed their names as Witnesses to this Will in
the presence, and at the Request of the Testator in, in the presence
of each other.
