 to my son Stephen Bordley Atkinson in the care of my friend
 Hyuson Smyth to be paid to him at the age of twenty one years
 Item I give and devise to my Daughter Temperance Atkinson Nine
 pounds Specie Item I likewise devise to my Daughter Temperance
 Atkinson my silk bonnet Cloath Cloak three Gounes one Apron
 and one petticoat to be in possession of said Hyuson Smyth until
 she is of proper age to receive the same Item I give & devise all
 the Residue of my Estate to my friend Hyuson Smyth
 Lastly I do confirm this to be my last Will and Testament
 Revoking and Disannulling all other Will or Wills heretofore made
 as Witness my Hand and Seal this Twentifourth day of November
 Seven hundred and Eighty three

December 22. 1783 Then came Nathan Smyth Hannah Lynch and

 and that they heard her publish & pronounce & declare the same to be her last
 Will & Testament, And that ^{at the same time} she was to the best of their apprehensions of sound
 disposing mind & memory ~~and understanding~~ and that they subscribed
 their names as Witnesses thereto in the presence and at the request of the
 Testator and in the presence of each other
