Viz. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha Turner (during her Life) that part of my land together with the appurtenances thereto belonging that I purchased of a certain Joseph Hall, called & known by the name of Suffolk containing by Patent one hundred & fifty acres of Land, Also I devise unto my said wife Martha Turner for during the term of nine years to commence from the day of my death, all the remainder of my Lands with the appurtenances thereto belonging called and known by the name of Suffolk in order to enable my said wife the better to bring up educate and maintain my younger children.
