 my Daughter Elizabeth Turner in part of her equal proportion of  
 my personal Estate one Negro girl named Rebecca. I give and bequeath  
 unto my Daughter Sarah Turner in part of her equal proportion of  
 my personal Estate one Negro girl named Rachel. I give and bequeath  
 unto my Daughter Araminta in part of her equal proportion of my  
 personal Estate one Negro girl named Ann. I give and bequeath  
 unto my son John Turner in part of his equal proportion of my  
~~personal~~ Estate one Negro fellow named Edward. I give and bequeath  
 unto my son Joseph in part of his equal proportion of my personal  
 Estate one Negro Boy named Isack, I give and bequeath unto my  
 son Daniel Turner over and above his equal proportion of my  
 personal Estate one black Horse that he commonly rides. I give and  
 bequeath unto my son Dan<sup>r</sup> Turner one black Mare three years  
 old this Spring in part of his equal proportion of my personal Estate
