


In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Marley of Kent

 for the same, but calling to mind the certainty of death, and the
 uncertainty of this transitory life, do therefore commit my Body to
 the Earth to be buried in a Christian-like and decent manner
 at the discretion of my Exor hereafter named, and my Soul into the
 hands of God that gave it, and as touching such Worldly ~~Goods~~ Estate
 it has pleased the Almighty God to bless me with in this life I
 therefore dispose of the same in the following manner.

Item first of all my Will is that all my just Debts & funeral
 charges be paid out of my Estate by my Exors.

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Child Rebecca Marley the sum
 of Twenty shillings common money

Item I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Priscilla Marley
 Daughter of Abraham the sum of thirty shillings Specie

Item I give & bequeath unto my dearly beloved daughter ^{Martha Louver} wife of James Louver
 the residue & remainder of my whole Worldly Estate Real & personal to her &
 her heirs for ever. Lastly I constitute make & ordain James Louver my son
 in Law whole & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament disallowing &
 revoking all former Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made, Ratifying &
 confirming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Twentieth day of July in the
 year of our Lord Christ Seventeen hundred & Eighty four. 1784.

At August. 20. 1784 There came William Dodson & Thomas Wells two of the
 Subscribing witnesses to the within last Will and Testament of Elizabeth
 Marley late of Kent County dead, and made Oath on the Holy Evangelists of
 Almighty God, that they did see the testator therein named sign & seal this
 Will and that they heard her publish pronounce & declare the same
