Two of the Subscribing Witnesses to the within Last Will and Testament of  
 John Williamson late of Kent County deceased, and severally made Oath on  
 the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God, that they did see the Testator  
 therein named sign and seal this Will, and that they heard him  
 publish pronounce and declare the same to be his last Will and  
 Testament, that at the time of his so doing, he was to the best of their  
 apprehensions, of sound disposing mind, memory and understanding;  
 And that they these deponents together with William Wordley the other  
 Subscribing Witness above named, subscribed their names as Witnesses to  
 this Will, in the presence, and at the request of the Testator, and in  
 the presence of each other.

 gave it me, secondly to be buried decently at the discretion of my Exe-  
 cutors hereafter mentioned named, thirdly I request that all my just debts be  
 paid and satisfied out of my Estate.
