CHAPTER 5

(House Bill 51 of 1979)

AN ACT concerning

Motion Picture and Television Development  
Office and Advisory Council

FOR the purpose of creating the Motion Picture and Television Development Office and Motion Picture and Television Development Advisory Council within the Department of Economic and Community Development; establishing the membership, term, appointment, and functioning of the Council; giving the Office and Council certain powers and responsibilities; requiring the Council to serve as an advisory body to the Department of Economic and Community Development in developing and implementing a program to promote the production of motion pictures and television within this State; specifying what this program shall include; requiring the Office and Council to coordinate the with activities of similar agencies established by local governments; and requiring the Council to recommend to the Department of Economic and Community Development any legislative or administrative actions necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.
