THAN \$13,000 a year each. The third shall serve as the Assistant State's Attorney for the District Court and receive not less than \$10,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 230

(House Bill 1522)

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County - Friendship Heights Village Council MC 226B-80

FOR the purpose of expanding those purposes for which funds collected by the Friendship Heights Village Council may be used and providing the Council with certain powers; providing for the construction of certain roads; eliminating the right of certain property-owners to petition for road improvements; and granting Montgomery County the power to construct certain roads appearing on certain plans approved by the County and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission; providing that certain petitions may be received by the Friendship Heights Village Council until a certain date; and generally relating to the powers of the Friendship Heights Village Council.
