CHAPTER 274

(House Bill 519)

AN ACT concerning

State Parks - Senior Citizens' Fees

FOR the purpose of providing that certain persons who possess a Maryland Golden Age Pass need only pay a certain part of the established fee for overnight camping in State parks during certain times of the week.

BY adding to

Article - Natural Resources Section 5-1007 Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

5-1007.

A PERSON 62 YEARS OLD OR OLDER WHO POSSESSES A MARYLAND GOLDEN AGE PASS, ISSUED BY THE MARYLAND PARK SERVICE, MAY CAMP OVERNIGHT IN ANY STATE PARK AT ONE-HALF OF THE ESTABLISHED FEE MONDAY THROUGH THURSDAY, EXCLUDING HOLIDAYS.
