SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

## CHAPTER 275

(House Bill 549)

AN ACT concerning

Teachers' Retirement and Teachers' Pension Systems

FOR the purpose of providing that a member of the Teachers' Retirement System or the Teachers' Pension System may continue his employment at the age of 70 for a certain period of time by application to the State Board of Education er, the State Superintendent of Schools, or, in the case of higher education, to a member's appointing authority; permitting the further continuation of employment under certain circumstances; providing for a hearing before the Maryland Employees Retirement Review Board upon disapproval of the application; increasing the number of members on the Maryland Employees Retirement Review Board; repealing a provision which allows a member of the Teachers' Retirement System who attained the age of 70 during World War II or a retired member who was in service on January 1, 1942 to remain or be reinstated in service under certain circumstances; providing an effective date for this Act; and making stylistic changes.
