~~(F) ANY PERSON WHO FAILS OR REFUSES TO MAKE A REPORT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.~~
