AN INVESTIGATION OR IN A JUDICIAL PROCEEDING ARISING FROM A REPORT IS IMMUNE FROM ANY CIVIL LIABILITY FOR THIS ACTION.

(E)--ANY--PERSON--WHO-ABUSES-A-MENTALLY-RETARDED-PERSON UNDER-THIS--SECTION--IS--GUILTY--OF--A--MISDEMEANOR--AND--ON GONVICTION--IS--SUBJECT--TO--A--FINE-NOT-EXCEEDING-\$1,000-OR IMPRISONMENT-FOR-NOT-MORE-THAN-18-MONTHS-OR-BOTH--FINED--AND IMPRISONED.

(F)--ANY--PERSON--WHO-FAILS-OR-REFUSES-TO-MAKE-A-REPORT REQUIRED-UNDER-THIS-SECTION-IS-GUILTY-OF-A--MISDEMEANOR--AND ON-GONVICTION-IS-SUBJECT-TO-A-FINE-NOT-EXCEEDING-\$1,000;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
