Real Property - Ground Rent Disclosure

FOR the purpose of requiring certain disclosures by-the seller-at-the--time--of--settlement--on--real--property subject-to-a ground rent; and specifying a particular effective date for this Act.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

- (I) THAT THE FOLDER REVERSIONARY OWNER OF THE GROUND RENT MAY BRING AN ACTION OF EJECTMENT AGAINST THE LEASEFPLOER GROUND RENT TENANT UNDER § 8-402(C) OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- (II) AS A RESULT OF THE EJECTMENT ACTION, THE HOLDER REVERSIONARY OWNER OF THE GROUND RENT MAY OWN THE PROPERTY FREE-AND-GLEAR IN FEE, DISCHARGED FROM THE LEASE.
