SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 81 - Revenue and Taxes

~~(A)--EXECUTIVE-AND-ADMINISTRATIVE-DEPARTMENTS, OFFICES, BOARDS, AND OTHER UNITS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT SHALL NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY LEGAL OFFICER OF PENDING LITIGATION AFFECTING HIS COUNTY TO WHICH THEY ARE A PARTY.~~

~~(B)--UPON NOTIFICATION OF PENDING LITIGATION AFFECTING LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THE COUNTY LEGAL OFFICER MAY ENTER THE COUNTY'S APPEARANCE IN THE LITIGATION.~~

THE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION SHALL NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY LEGAL OFFICER OF ANY ASSESSMENT APPEAL FILED WITH THE LOCAL SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS WHEN THE AMOUNT OF THE PROPOSED FULL CASH VALUE OF THE PROPERTY EXCEEDS \$250,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
