~~{3}~~ (2) COPIES OF THE COMPLETE TEXT OF ALL CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS AND REFERENDUM QUESTIONS SHALL BE FURNISHED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS TO THE LOCAL BOARDS OF ELECTION IN QUANTITIES AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATOR OF ELECTION LAWS, INCLUDING QUANTITIES SUFFICIENT TO PROVIDE ONE COPY OF EACH FOR POSTING IN EACH POLLING PLACE AND IN EACH BOARD OFFICE.

~~{4}~~ (3) ANYONE MAY REQUEST A COPY OF THE COMPLETE TEXT OF ALL CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS AND REFERENDUM QUESTIONS FROM ANY LOCAL BOARD OF ELECTION, WHICH SHALL BE MAILED WITHOUT CHARGE TO THE PERSON MAKING THE REQUEST.
