

(1) BEFORE MAY 2, 1973:

(I) MET THE BOARD QUALIFICATIONS FOR A FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE; AND

(II) WAS ISSUED A FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE BY THE BOARD;

(2) HAS ANNUALLY RENEWED HIS FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE SINCE MAY 2, 1973;

(3) APPLIES FOR A FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE BEFORE MAY 1, 1980 ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES; AND

(4) PAYS TO THE BOARD A LICENSE FEE OF \$25.

(C) A FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE ISSUED TO AN INDIVIDUAL AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE FUNERAL DIRECTION WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

(D) A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION EXPIRES ON THE MAY 1 AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, UNLESS THE LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM.

(1) THE HOLDER OF A FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE MAY RENEW HIS LICENSE, IF THE LICENSEE:

(I) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;

(II) HAS ANNUALLY RENEWED HIS FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE;

(III) PAYS TO THE BOARD A RENEWAL FEE OF \$25; AND

(IV) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT IT REQUIRES.

(2) THE BOARD SHALL RENEW THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S LICENSE OF EACH LICENSEE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
