(III) A UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND EMPLOYEE WHO IS NOT DESIGNATED TO BE TREATED AS A CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEE BY THE UNIVERSITY UNDER § 13-1A-02(B) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE; OR

(IV) A PERSON WHO:

- 1. IS EMPLOYED BY A UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE THAT IS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES, AS PROVIDED UNDER TITLE 14 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, OR IS EMPLOYED BY MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY OR ST. MARY'S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND; AND
 - 2. WHO IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE MERIT

SYSTEM LAW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
