AT ALL TIMES DURING BUSINESS HOURS PERSONNEL WHO ARE CERTIFIED TO ADMINISTER CARDIO-PULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR).

(B) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED AS CREATING ANY CIVIL OR CRIMINAL LIABILITY FOR ANY PERSON.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 364

(House Bill 20)

AN ACT concerning

Public Service Commission - Telephone Charges

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Public Service Commission from authorizing <u>any mandatory</u> telephone company charges based on a measured time period unit rate for local messages; <u>and providing an exception for computer data transmissions after a certain date</u>.

BY adding to

Article 78 - Public Service Commission Law Section 68(d) Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 78 - Public Service Commission Law

- (D)(1) THE COMMISSION MAY NOT AUTHORIZE ANY MANDATORY TELEPHONE COMPANY CHARGES BASED ON A MEASURED TIME PERIOD UNIT RATE FOR LOCAL MESSAGES EXCEPT FOR-COMPUTER-DATA TRANSMISSIONS AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- (2) AFTER JUNE 30, 1981, FOR COMPUTER DATA TRANSMISSIONS, THE COMMISSION MAY AUTHORIZE MANDATORY TELEPHONE COMPANY CHARGES BASED ON A COST-JUSTIFIED MEASURED TIME PERIOD UNIT RATE FOR LOCAL MESSAGES
