CHAPTER 370

(House Bill 152)

AN ACT concerning

Firebomb or "Molotov Cocktail" - Feleny Penalties

FOR the purpose of altering the penalty--and--making--it--a feleny penalties for the offense that makes it unlawful to manufacture, assemble, use or possess any device commonly known as a firebomb or a "Molotov cocktail"; and clarifying language.

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments Section 139A Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
