received under the Social Security Act, the Railroad Retirement Act, or both, as the case may be; AND (11) AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE TOTAL OF POLITICAL AND NEWSLETTER FUND CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY A NONFIDUCIARY INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER IN THE TAXABLE YEAR, AS DETERMINED, CALCULATED, AND LIMITED BY THE PROVISIONS OF § 41 OF THE FEDERAL INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980, and shall apply to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 1979.

CHAPTER 374

(House Bill 193)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland-Racing-Commission Licensed Racetracks - Sunday Racing

FOR the purpose of prohibiting Sunday racing in-this-State at licensed racetracks in this State, providing for a certain exception; and generally relating to Sunday racing.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 78B - Racing Commission Section 28 Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 78B - Racing Commission

28.

Netwithstanding-any-other-provisions-of--this--articler racing--may NOT be--conducted-at-any-licensed-racetrack-in [Worcester-County-on-Sunday,-with-the-approval-of-the-Racing Commission-and-of-the-County-Commissioners] THIS--STATE--ON ANY-SUNDAY:

(A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, RACING MAY NOT BE CONDUCTED ON ANY SUNDAY AT LICENSED RACETRACKS IN BALTIMORE CITY, ANNE ARUNDEL, BALTIMORE, HOWARD AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTIES.
