(a) During each term in office, each Delegate may $\mathbf{award} + \mathbf{c}$

(1)--Two-4-year-full-time-scholarships;

(2)--Four-2-year-full-time-scholarships;-for

(3)--One--4-year--full-time--scholarship--and-two 2-year-full-time-scholarships;

(4)--EIGHT-1-YEAR-FULL-TIME-SCHOLARSHIPS;-OR

(5)--ANY--COMBINATION--OF---1,---2,---OR---4-YEAR SCHOLARSHIPS-THAT-TOTAL-NO-MORE-THAN-16-SEMESTERS-OF-AWARDS-AWARD THE EQUIVALENT OF TWO 4-YEAR FULL-TIME SCHOLARSHIPS, WHICH MAY BE AWARDED FOR EITHER 1, 2, 3, OR 4 YEAR PERIODS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 386

(House Bill 410)

AN ACT concerning

Interest and Usury - Finance Charges
