SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

(a) (10) MANURE BANKS OR OTHER FACILITIES (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF FACILITIES USED FOR THE STORAGE OF WASTE FROM POULTRY), ABOVE OR BELOW GROUND, USED IN THE PROCESS OF AGRICULTURAL LIVESTOCK PRODUCTION FOR STORING ANIMAL WASTES AND RUNOFF AREAS IN WHICH LIVESTOCK IS CONFINED SHALL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE VALUATION OF THE PROPERTY ON WHICH LOCATED FOR PURPOSES OF STATE AND COUNTY TAXATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
