

Vehicle Laws - Driver's License Suspension

FOR the purpose of ~~repealing-the-provision-for~~ specifying the circumstances under which the Motor Vehicle Administration shall reinstate a person's license to drive that has been suspended after the person has been rejected for insurance by the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund and failed to furnish evidence of required security; amending the provisions pertaining to the suspension of a driver's license as a result of insurance cancellation, termination, or lapse; providing for the issuance of a "Maryland Only" license to certain driver's license applicants who have been suspended in another jurisdiction as a result of failing to comply with the financial requirements; and specifying conditions for reinstatement of a suspended registration; and generally relating to the suspension and reinstatement of automobile registration and drivers' licenses for insurance related reasons.
