

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 41 - Governor-Executive and
Administrative Departments

70A.

(a) As used in this section:

(4) "Law-enforcement unit" means any governmental police force, sheriff's department, security force or law-enforcement organization of the State, county, or municipality which has by statute, ordinance, or common law, the authority or the responsibility [of] FOR detecting crime [or] AND FOR enforcing the general criminal laws of this State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
