THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY MAY ESTABLISH BY RESOLUTION A SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE PAID BY THE DRAWER OF ANY CHECKS, DRAFTS, OR OTHER NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS FOR ANY OBLIGATION DUE TO THE TREASURER OF FREDERICK COUNTY OR THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY, WHICH ARE DISHONORED BY THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTION UPON WHICH THE CHECKS, DRAFTS, OR OTHER NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS ARE DRAWN FOR THE REASON OF "INSUFFICIENT FUNDS", OR "NO ACCOUNT", AS DEFINED IN SECTION 40(D) OF ARTICLE 27 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND. THE FEES SHALL BE DUE AND PAYABLE TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR TREASURER OF FREDERICK COUNTY UPON RETURN BY THE DRAWEE OF THE INSTRUMENTS REFERRED TO ABOVE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Bad Check Fee
