SECTION 3.---AND--BE--IT--FURTHER--ENACTED,--That--the effectiveness-of-this-Act-is-contingent-on-the-taking-effect of-Chapter-----{H.B.-1950}-of-the-Acts-of-1980.

SECTION--2 4.---AND--BE--IT--FURTHER--ENACTED,--That,--subject to-the-provisions-of-Section-3-of-this-Act, this--Act--shall take-effect-July-1,--1980.

FOR the purpose of authorizing the transfer of certain racing revenues received by Prince George's County to the State of Maryland for the costs of project planning and final engineering for an access road to the Bowie Racetrack.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That subject to an agreement between Prince George's County and the State Highway Administration, Maryland Department of Transportation, as much of the funds which have been received by the county as of the effective date of this Act pursuant to Section 19(d) of Article 78B of the Annotated Code of Maryland as may be fixed by the agreement shall be transferred from Prince George's County to the State of Maryland and deposited in the Transportation Trust Fund for the purpose of project planning and final engineering for an access road to the Bowie Racetrack.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
