

~~SECTION 10. --AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That--this--Act shall take effect June 1, 1980.~~

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That before this Act becomes effective it shall first be submitted to a referendum of the legally qualified voters of Queen Anne's County at the general election to be held in November of 1980. The Board of County Commissioners and the Board of Supervisors of Election of Queen Anne's County shall do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the referendum here required. There shall be printed on the ballots or ballot labels to be used at this election the title of this Act and underneath the title, on separate lines, a square or box to the right of and opposite the words: "For County Office Bonds" and a corresponding square or box to the right of and opposite the words "Against County Office Bonds" so that each voter of the county may designate his or her decision for or against the provisions of this Act. If a majority of the votes cast in the election are "For County Office Bonds" the provisions of this Act shall become effective on the 30th day following the official canvass of votes for the referendum, but if a majority of the votes cast in the election are "Against County Office Bonds" the provisions of this Act shall be of no effect and null and void.

SECTION 11. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That subject to the provisions of Section 10 herein and for the sole purpose of providing for the referendum therein required, this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1980.

AN ACT concerning

Law Enforcement - Form of Citations
