AN ACT concerning

Health - Laboratory Examination - Reports

FOR the purpose of requiring, that with respect to reports of tests of gonorrhea and syphilis, the name and address of the person from whom a specimen was obtained will be placed on certain reports.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND; That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

(d) ~~{1} With respect to reports of tests of evidence of gonorrhea and syphilis only, each report shall be in writing on a form provided by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and shall include: (i) the date, type, and results of the test performed, and the case number, (ii) the age, sex, NAME, and {political subdivision} ADDRESS of residence of the person from whom the specimen was obtained, and (iii) the name and address of the physician for whom the examination was performed.~~
