~~(C) -- AN ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION CREATING -- A -- DEPARTMENT OF -- PUBLIC -- FACILITIES -- AND -- SERVICES -- SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE RETIRING, REFUNDING, REFINANCING, TRANSFER, OR ASSUMPTION OF ANY EXISTING APPLICABLE OUTSTANDING BONDED -- INDEBTEDNESS -- OF THE COUNTY AUTHORITY, DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION WHICH PRECEDED IT.~~

(C) IF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CREATE A DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC FACILITIES AND SERVICES WHICH INCLUDES WATER AND SEWERAGE FUNCTIONS, THEY SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE ABOLITION OF ANY WATER OR SEWER AUTHORITY CREATED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR BY PUBLIC LOCAL LAW ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 445 THROUGH 466 OF ARTICLE 43 OF THIS CODE, AND SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE ABOLITION OF ANY SANITARY DISTRICT OR COMMISSION CREATED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 645 THROUGH 673 OF ARTICLE 43.

(D) ANY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION ABOLISHING A WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY, SANITARY DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE:

(1) THAT ALL PROPERTY, REAL AND PERSONAL, OF ANY WATER OR SEWER AUTHORITY, SANITARY DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION SO ABOLISHED, SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO CALVERT COUNTY;

(2) FOR THE RETIRING, REFUNDING, REFINANCING, TRANSFER, OR ASSUMPTION OF ANY EXISTING APPLICABLE OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS, AND FOR COUNTY ASSUMPTION OF ALL EXISTING ASSETS AND LIABILITIES OF THE AUTHORITY, DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION SO ABOLISHED, SUBJECT TO AN AUDIT BY A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT OF THE ASSETS AND LIABILITIES TO BE ASSUMED;

(3) FOR COUNTY RESPONSIBILITY AND ADMINISTRATION OF AGREEMENTS AND CONTRACTS LEGALLY ENFORCEABLE BETWEEN THE AUTHORITY, DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION AND OTHER PARTIES;

(4) THAT ALL ORDERS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS MADE BY ANY AUTHORITY, DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION SO ABOLISHED SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL REVOKED OR MODIFIED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; AND

(5) THAT ALL MATTERS PENDING BEFORE ANY AUTHORITY, DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION ABOLISHED MAY CONTINUE AND SHALL BE COMPLETED BY THE NEW DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC FACILITIES AND SERVICES.

(E) PRIOR TO THE ABOLITION OF ANY AUTHORITY, DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY REQUEST THAT THE AUTHORITY, DISTRICT, OR COMMISSION, FURNISH LISTS, OR OTHER APPROPRIATE INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTATION TO ASSIST THE
