

ADDICTED PRISONERS AND WHICH IS KNOWN AS THE JESSUP PRE-RELEASE ANNEX (DRUG) FACILITY; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SHOULD ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY NOT EXECUTE, BY AUGUST 1, 1980, AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF MARYLAND WHEREBY THE COUNTY SHALL THEREAFTER SUPPLY EMERGENCY WATER SERVICES TO THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION FOR THE HOUSE OF CORRECTION COMPLEX, THE SITE OF THE 500 BED FACILITY PROVIDED FOR HEREIN SHALL BE THAT PROPERTY OWNED BY THE STATE OF MARYLAND IN HOWARD COUNTY ADJACENT TO THE CLIFTON T. PERKINS HOSPITAL. AS OF THE DATE ON WHICH THE 500 BED REPLACEMENT FACILITY AUTHORIZED HEREIN IS OPEN AND ACCEPTING PRISONERS, THE TOTAL DIVISION OF CORRECTION AND PATUXENT INSTITUTION PRISON POPULATION IN THE JESSUP AREA SHALL NOT EXCEED 3,400 PRISONERS, COMPUTING AS FOLLOWS:
