- (b) On application, the Administration shall issue a [special] Class F "farm truck tractor" registration to any applicant who certifies:
 - (1) That the applicant is a farmer; and
- (2) That the vehicle for which the application is made is a farm truck tractor, specifying its proposed use.
- (c) For each farm truck tractor [in the following subclassifications, as defined in subsection (d) of this section,] the annual registration fee[, with] IS BASED ON THE maximum gross weight [limitations for] OF the vehicle in combination with a trailer or semitrailer, [is] as follows:

- (d) [(1) A farm truck tractor with two or more axles may be registered in Class FE, FF, and FG.
- (2) Class FH registration is limited to farm truck tractor with three or more axles.]
- [(e)] A vehicle registered under this section may not be used:
 - (1) For hire; or
- (2) In any manner other than as a farm truck tractor.

- (a) (1) When registered with the Administration, every trailer and semitrailer is a Class G (trailer) vehicle.
- (2) A CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLE SHALL BE CLASSIFIED AS "FREIGHT" OR "NONFREIGHT."
- [(b) Except as otherwise provided in this part, for each Class G (trailer) vehicle, the annual registration fee is based on the shipping weight of its chassis, as certified
