CHAPTER 540

(Senate Bill 94)

AN ACT concerning

Controlled Dangerous Substances - Bringing into State

FOR the purpose of providing that it is unlawful for any person to bring into this State certain controlled dangerous substances in certain amounts; and providing a penalty.

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments Section 286A Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

(2)--MORE-THAN-28-GRAMS-OF-GOGAINE-OR-ANY-MIXTURE GONTAINING-GOGAINE;-OR

(3)--MORE-THAN-4-GRAMS-OF-MORPHINE--OR--OPIUM--OR ANY--DERIVATIVE,--SALT,--ISOMER,--OR--SALT--OF--AN-ISOMER-OF MORPHINE-OR-OPIUM.

(B)--ANY-PERSON-VIOLATING-THIS-SECTION-IS-GUILTY--OF--A FELONY--AND-SUBJECT--TO-A-FINE-OF-NOT-MORE-THAN-\$50,000-AND IMPRISONMENT-FOR-NOT-MORE-THAN-25-YEARS+
