

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Motor Vehicle Administration shall refund to the Lions-Club-of-District-22-C Lions of District 22-C Eye Bank & Research Foundation, Inc. the amount of the Motor Vehicle Excise Tax paid upon issuance of a certificate of title for the motor vehicle owned and operated by the Lions-Club-of-District 22-C Lions of District 22-C Eye Bank & Research Foundation, Inc. and used as a Hearing and Eye Screening Mobile Unit.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
