CHAPTER 591

(House Bill 167)

AN ACT concerning

Condominiums - Amendment of Bylaws

FOR the purpose of changing the percentage of the votes necessary to amend the bylaws of a condominium; and providing an exception to this percentage of votes that is prescribed by statute.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Real Property

11-104.

(e) (1) [The] UNLESS A HIGHER PERCENTAGE IS REQUIRED IN THE BYLAWS, THE bylaws may be amended by the affirmative vote of unit owners having [75] 66 2/3 percent or more of the votes. Each particular set forth in subsection (b) shall be expressed in the bylaws as amended. An amendment shall be entitled to be recorded if accompanied by a certificate of the person specified in the bylaws to count votes at the meeting of the council of unit owners that the amendment was approved by unit owners having [at least 75
