- [(e) In Prince George's County the hours during which alcoholic beverages may be sold or delivered to retail license holders by holders of wholesalers' licenses shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, on every day except Sundays.]
- [(f) In Harford County the hours during which alcoholic beverages may be sold or delivered to retail license holders by holders of a wholesaler license are from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight on every day of the week, except Sundays.]

- (a) (1) It is unlawful for the keeper of any hotel, tavern, store, drinking establishment or any other place where liquors are sold, or for any person or persons, directly or indirectly, to sell, barter, give or dispose of any spirituous or fermented liquors, ale or beer, or intoxicating drinks of any kind within any election district or precinct of this State on the day of any general, special or primary election to be held in any district or precinct during the hours when the polls are open. Any person violating the provisions of this section is liable for indictment, and upon conviction is fined not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for each offense.
- (2) On the day of any election any restaurant holding any license issued under the provisions of this article may dispense those alcoholic beverages that are in accordance with that license for consumption on the premises only. However,-the-provisions-of-this-paragraph-de-net apply-te-Geeilf; AND Kentf,--er-Queen-Anne's]-counties. [However, the provisions of this paragraph do not apply to Cecil, Kent, or Queen Anne's counties.]
