

(iv) The governing body of the county and, where applicable, the city where the project is located have entered into an agreement with the owner for the payment of negotiated amounts in lieu of all county and city taxes, providing for apportionment, where applicable, between the county and city.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 645

(House Bill 1469)

AN ACT concerning

Discipline of Physicians

FOR the purpose of providing that the failure of a physician to meet certain standards of quality ~~medical--care~~ surgical care performed in certain outpatient facilities is unprofessional conduct to be used by the Commission on Medical Discipline in disciplining a physician.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter 621 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1980) be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
