- (D) A PRISONER EMPLOYED IN THE COMMUNITY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED TO BE AN AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF CALVERT COUNTY, THE SHERIFF OF THE COUNTY, OR ANY OTHER JUDICIAL OR PUBLIC OFFICER OF THE COUNTY.
- (E) IN THE EVENT OF ANY VIOLATION OF TRUST OR CONDITIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE SUPERVISOR, FOR CONDUCT AND EMPLOYMENT, A PRISONER MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE PROGRAM AND ANY EARNED DIMINUTION MAY BE CANCELLED. FAILURE OF A PRISONER TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF HIS AUTHORIZATION FOR LEAVE SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS A VIOLATION OF THE PROVISION OF SECTION 139 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 669

(House Bill 1704)

AN ACT concerning

Viet Nam Veterans - Preference

FOR the purpose of extending the effective period during which certain Viet Nam Veterans shall be given special credit in all examinations for initial appointment and employment within the State; and clarifying language.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

(c-1) If a veteran eligible for credit under this section served in the armed forces of the United States for a period in excess of six months during the period August 4, 1964 through March-317-1973 MAY 7, 1975, [he shall be given
