

amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and when due and until paid in full, such principal to be discharged within fifteen years of the date of issue of the bonds.

(5) The payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the purpose set forth in Section 1(3), above, shall be contingent upon the provision ~~by Baltimore City~~ of a sum up to \$600,000 as a matching fund for this project in the ratio of \$1 of State funds for every \$2 of ~~City Baltimore City and other non-State funds~~. Baltimore City shall have until June 1, 1982, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works of the sum that ~~it has--raised--as~~ a matching fund has been raised for this purpose. Upon a certification of suitable evidence from the Board of Public Works on or before June 1, 1982, the proceeds of the loan shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of this Act. To the extent that satisfactory evidence of the raising of a sum up to \$600,000 as a matching fund of this project is not presented to the Board of Public Works on or before June 1, 1982, no funds under the provisions of this Act shall thereafter be paid over to or expended for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3), above, and the remaining proceeds of the loan shall be transferred to the Annuity Bond Fund and applied to the debt service requirements of the State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1980.
