The membership of this retirement system shall be composed as follows:

(3a) (f) Any member of the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Maryland who transferred his credit from the employees' retirement system of the City of Baltimore prior to July 1, 1971, from and after July 1, 1972, shall pay the rate of contribution for his attained age at the time of his enrollment in the city system which was in effect at the time of his enrollment in the State Teachers' System, except that said rate shall not exceed 5 percent as provided in [§ 89(2)(a)] § 89(1)(A) of this subtitle.
