(c) (2) Until December 31, 1979, in the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, a person may not set or fish any gill net whose size of stretched mesh, allowing a 1/4 inch variable, is more than 7 inches. After December [13] 31, 1979, in the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, a person may not set or fish any gill net whose size of stretched mesh is more than 6 inches.

(g) (1) Any State resident desiring to catch crabs in the waters of the State for noncommercial purposes by using a trotline in excess of 300 feet first shall obtain a sports [crabber] CRABBER'S license.
