

[(c)] (D) "Junk" means old or scrap copper, brass, rope, rags, batteries, paper, trash, rubber debris, waste, iron, steel, and any other old or scrap material[, including wrecked, scrapped, ruined, or dismantled motor vehicles or motor vehicle parts].

[(d)] (E) "Junkyard" means an establishment or place of business that is maintained, operated, or used:

- junk;
- (1) For storing, keeping, buying, or selling
 - (2) For an automobile graveyard;
 - (3) As a garbage dump or sanitary fill; [or]
 - (4) As a scrap metal processing facility; OR
 - (5) AS AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER OR RECYCLER FACILITY.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
