Vehicle Laws - Use of Lighting Equipment

FOR the purpose of permitting the use of certain lighting equipment by certain vehicles under certain circumstances.

BY adding to

Article - Transportation Section 22-218-3 22-221(f) Annotated Code of Maryland (1977 Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

22-218-3- 22-221.

(F) WARNING LAMPS MAY BE USED BY THE OPERATOR OF ANY VEHICLE HAVING-A-GROSS-WEIGHT-OF-40,000-POUNDS-OR-MORE WHEN THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT IS IN EXCESS OF 45 MILES PER HOUR AND THE VEHICLE IS TRAVELING AT LEAST 20 MILES PER HOUR UNDER THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
