(House Bill 924)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Caroline County Jail Loan of 1980

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000), the proceeds to be used for financing the costs of alteration, enlargement, extension, expansion, improvement, reconstruction, rehabilitation, renovation, and repair of the Caroline County Jail, subject to the requirement that Caroline County provide at least an equal and matching amount for the same purpose; providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Caroline County Jail Loan of 1980 in the aggregate principal amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000). This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23, inclusive, of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement, as amended from time to time).
- (2) The bonds issued to evidence this loan or installments thereof may be sold as a single issue, or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under § 2B of Article 31 of the Code.
- (3) The actual cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and shall be first applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing and delivering the unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided and thereafter shall be credited on the books of the State Comptroller and expended, upon approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including fees: any architects' and engineers' applicable alteration, enlargement, extension, expansion, improvement, reconstruction, rehabilitation, renovation and repair of the Caroline County Jail, including the costs of acquisition and development of property rights, acquisition and installation of furnishings and equipment and any related financial and planning services.
- (4) There is hereby levied and imposed an annual State tax on all assessable property in the State in rate and
